

Discussion Guide for The Death of God: Part 2

1. Read Luke 23:32-43 and review the sermon outline.

What parts of Sunday's lesson did you find helpful, enlightening, unclear or troubling?

2. Truth: The words spoken at the crucifixion were starkly vile and gracious. Vile from Jesus' enemies. Gracious for Jesus Himself.

Read Luke 23:35-40

How do you see the gospel preached in the sarcasm of Luke 23:35-40?

What was the effect on the other thief in v.41-43?

How do you see true faith in the words of the repentant thief?

Do you think the thief deserved that last-minute salvation?

How does this story give you hope for the long time unbelievers that you care about?

How does it sit with you that very bad people could potentially generally convert and experience full forgiveness and eternal reward?

Read Matthew 20:1-16

How does this parable shape our thinking about last-minute salvation?

What is the quality of God that we are directed towards in v.15?

Have you seen genuine late in life conversions in your own experience? Share what happened.

Is there any long time unbeliever you your life that you have secretly though is a lost cause? Can you commit to praying for their salvation?

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
