

## Discussion Guide for John 14:6-7

### 1. Read John 14:6-7 and briefly review the sermon outline.

What parts of Sunday's lesson did you find helpful, enlightening, unclear or troubling?

**2. Truth:** We have been powerfully changed by Christ and are now God's ambassadors to tell others about the way of salvation by faith in Christ.

### Read 1 Peter 2:9-10

-For what reason did God save us in 2:9?

-How does God's description of us in 2:9 encourage you in your role of God's ambassador?

We have each experienced the life-changing power of God in our salvation. God simply calls us to testify from personal experience about His power. We can do this in day-to-day conversations.

-Peter says that God "called you out of darkness into his marvelous light". We have been changed morally by God. What kind of normal conversation might be an open door to testify about God's power to free from sin's hold?

-Peter says, "Once you were not a people, but now you are God's people". We are now God's beloved children. What kind of normal conversation might be an open door to testify about how acceptance by God has changed your life?

-Peter says, "once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy". What kind of conversation might be an open door to testify about the mercy and forgiveness that you have received?
