

## Discussion Guide for John 14:6-7

### 1. Read John 14:6-7 and briefly review the sermon outline.

What parts of Sunday's lesson did you find helpful, enlightening, unclear or troubling?

**2. Truth:** Those trapped in false religions are trapped in idolatry and compounding the just judgment of God. God commissions us to break the chains of false religion and bring the light of the Gospel.

What are the basics that we need to know about other religions if we're going to engage about the gospel?

Once you get past the costumes and trappings of various religions, most come down to: "Do good and follow our rules and you will be OK in the next life?" What does the Bible say about this approach?

How is this religious "do good" philosophy basically the same as the non-religious people around us?

### Read 1 Corinthians 10:19-22

- How does understanding of the demonic nature of false religion change your approach to spiritual people?

### Read and contrast Matthew 23:29-36 and Matthew 11:28-30

- How is Jesus' approach different with teachers of false religion and someone was deceived by it?  
- How does this instruct us as we interact with people of other religions?
