

Discussion Guide for John 14:6-7

1. Read John 14:6-7 and briefly review the sermon outline.

What parts of Sunday's lesson did you find helpful, enlightening, unclear or troubling?

2. **Truth:** There is one way to know God, be accepted by God and to spend eternity with God. This is by faith in and following Jesus.

*Jesus said, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life.

If we believe Jesus, what responsibility does this give us towards our neighbors who haven't found the "one way"?

Why do you think some people find this "one way" message so offensive?

How has this effected your openness to sharing Christ?

How is the gospel genuinely offensive to proud sinners?

How might our view of God and our view of man effect our reasoning about this issue?

How have you seen Christians making the gospel unnecessarily offensive to others?

What are some ways that we can faithfully but graciously share this "one way" truth with our unbelieving neighbors?
