

## Discussion Guide for Philippians 1:7-11 Part 2

**1. Read Philippians 1:7-11 and briefly review the sermon outline.**

**The target time is five minutes.**

What parts of Sunday's lesson did you find helpful, enlightening, unclear or troubling?

**2. Truth:** God fills up our joy as we invest in the mutual growth of one another. Our aim in discipleship is to build one another into faithful servants of Christ: running strong and ready for His return.

### **Read Titus 2:1-10**

What are some of the aspects of *internal* holiness that God wants to grow in us as His children and representatives?

What are some of the aspects of *behavioral* holiness that God want to create in us as His children and representatives?

Which of these internal attitudes or holy behaviors do you need to mature in most? And how might the other group members help you in this growth?

What is the relationship of these holy attitudes and behaviors to "sound doctrine" 2:1?

In these verses, Paul gives three purposes for living holy.

The purposes are indicated by "that" or "so that".

What are the three reasons to live holy?

### **Read Titus 2:9-14**

What is the "doctrine of God our Savoir" that we are supposed to "adorn" or make look attractive by the way we live? (see v.13)

How does our holiness today make the doctrine of Christ's anytime-return attractive and believable?
